- RN Students who have taken NAS 161 & 162 will require 4 additional general education elective credits, for a total of 19credits. NAS 161 and 162 is not an option for BCE and VCE students.
- Students admitted with a prior bachelor's degree do not have to take ENGH 302 but do have to take another elective to complete at least 30 hours at Mason beyond the first degree. If previous credits earned at Mason have been used for a degree at Mason or any other university, they cannot be used as electives for this degree.
- NURS classes are online and are offered in a 7-week or 15-week format, so students are expected to plan accordingly.
- Upon successful completion of NURS 336, RNs will be awarded a total of 33 credits. BCE and VCE students will receive 33credits upon completion of NURS 336 *and* proof of RN licensure.
- Once accepted into the nursing program, students must earn a C+ or better in NURS courses.
